

The share of Polish GDP in Europe's total GDP from 1990 until 2015




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

Poland is the sixth largest economy amongst 28 EU Member States. Six largest EU economies account for 52.5% of the total EU market.



#### **GDP** per capita in EU Member States, including PPS





# Gross Fixed Capital Formation (investments) in Poland and selected EU countries (as per cent of GDP)

**Gross Fixed Capital Formation** (investments) in Poland and the EU (as per cent of GDP)





2004–2014, in EUR mio)




Capital expenditure on fixed assets in the Polish economy on the real estate market by sectors (in the years 2004–2014, in EUR mio)




Capital expenditure on fixed assets in the Polish economy on the means of transport market by sectors (in the years 2004–2014, in EUR mio)

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

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
Investment finance leasing vs. investment loan from 2009 to 1H 2016 (in EUR billion)




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

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

# Total value of the Polish leasing market in the years 1995–2015





#### The Polish leasing market after Q3 2016

The structure of the market remains rather balanced: LCVs, machines, heavy haulage, with a lower share of real estate financing than in Western Europe.

The value of investments co-financed by the leasing sector to total Poland's GDP ratio is currently much higher than in other European countries.





#### **Eliminating threats**

1.
Eliminating the threat of introducing changes to the Civil Code that prevent the financing party to effectively claim amounts due under prematurely terminated contracts.


Eliminating the threat of exposing the sector to losses as a result of the tax authority's misinterpretation of VAT tax accounting principles in relation to reinvoicing of insurance of leased assets.

Eliminating the threat of excessive fiscalization of the sector following the enforcement of provisions on thin capitalisation

Eliminating the threat of exposing the sector to losses related to fines imposed on leasing, rental and RaC (rent a car) companies in relation to offences committed by drivers of vehicles.


